

We had two main water line breaks this year. We recommend flushing your water line when you experience low or no water pressure. We issue a Boil Water Advisory as a precaution. This is different than a Boil Water Order. A Boil Water Order is confirmation that contamination is present through bacteriological analysis. Whereas, a Boil Water Advisory is a precationary measure. Water samples are sent to KDHE who rescinds the BWA when test results come back negative for bacteria. KDHE notifies the media and we post it on our website.
